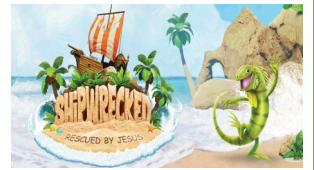
- Cooks (2-4 volunteers)

~ Help is needed on June 16th to register kids and promote our VBS at our Blacktop Bonanza Booth in Killam.

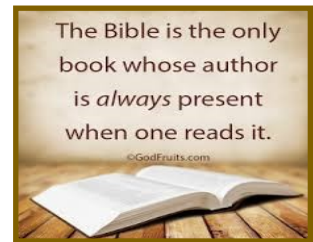
