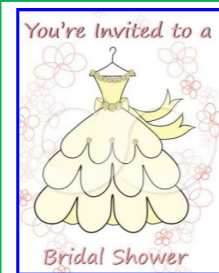

Application Questions

1. What is it about grumbling and questioning, that makes it impossible for a person to be "blameless and innocent", even when they are doing "all things" they have been asked to do? Why is it so important to Paul that our attitudes match our actions?
2. In verse 2:14--15 Paul is reflecting on Deuteronomy 32:5. In what ways were the Israelites prevented from being "lights in the world" because of their grumbling and questioning? How might "obedient" Christians similarly be prevented from being "lights in the world" by their bad attitudes?
3. What is "the word of life"? How would holding fast to the word of life enable the Philippians to remain joyful as they obeyed God?
4. Share an example of a situation that tempts you to grumble or complain.
5. How can you shine as a light in the world? Share an example of a way to shine the light.
6. What things are currently tempting you to complained and grumble about? What ideas can you think of that can help you deal with these things in healthy ways?
7. Currently, if people knew the 'real you,' would people be proud of you or not? What do you need to change?
8. Who can you get to know intentional, in order to gain the right to share the Gospel?
9. Truthfully, are you and the World much alike, or is there a sharp contrast between you and the World?
